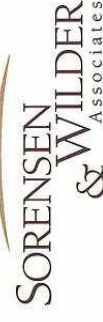

WHAT IS A FIRST RESPONDER?

A first responder is a person who has completed a 40 hour training program under the supervision of a certified instructor, and has passed a written and practical test administered by the Illinois Department of Public Health. The training is much more advanced than basic first aid training.



WHY OFFER THIS TRAINING?

In an emergency, quick response is crucial. A person not breathing may die within 4 to 6 minutes without proper treatment. And even in the best of circumstances, getting an ambulance to the scene within that time frame can be challenging.

The Medical First Responder program was developed to allow business and industry to prepare themselves to deal with on-site medical emergencies, and to provide basic, life saving care until an ambulance arrives on the scene. Today, with more and more companies developing Emergency Response Teams, the Medical First Responder plays an integral part in your emergency preparedness program.
